Who are the longest lived CEOs in the water business?

hat is the life expectancy of a CEO in the water industry? The List this month shows that it is generally under ten years, except under a few special circumstances. Being the founder or a big shareholder certainly helps, although in some cases (Biwater's Adrian White and

Future Pipe's Fouad Makhzoumi spring to mind) the challenge is not so much staying in the job, but being able to walk away. If you are not a founder or owner, the next best thing is to run a utility: these are long-term businesses that need long-term leaders like Wessex Water's Colin Skel-

lett, SJW's Rich Roth, and Dian Taylor at Artesian Resources. Otherwise, the highest ranked corporate honcho is Pentair's Randy Hogan at number 22, no doubt kept in place by the 278% share price rise he has overseen since taking on the role. He steps down as CEO later this year.
